Project Exclusions:

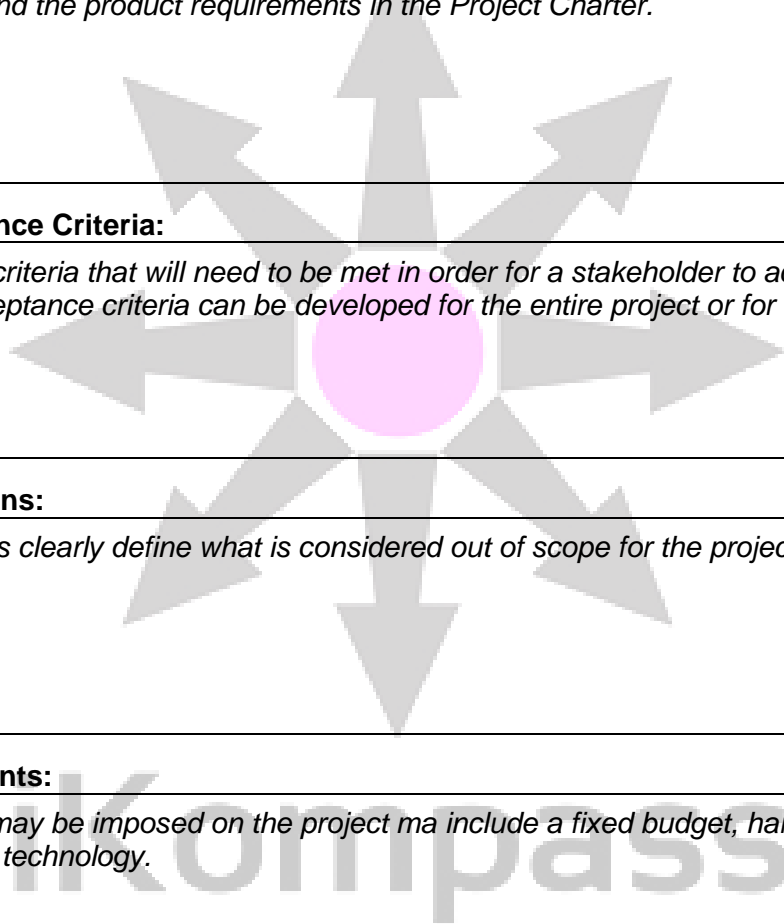
Project exclusions clearly define what is considered out of scope for the project.

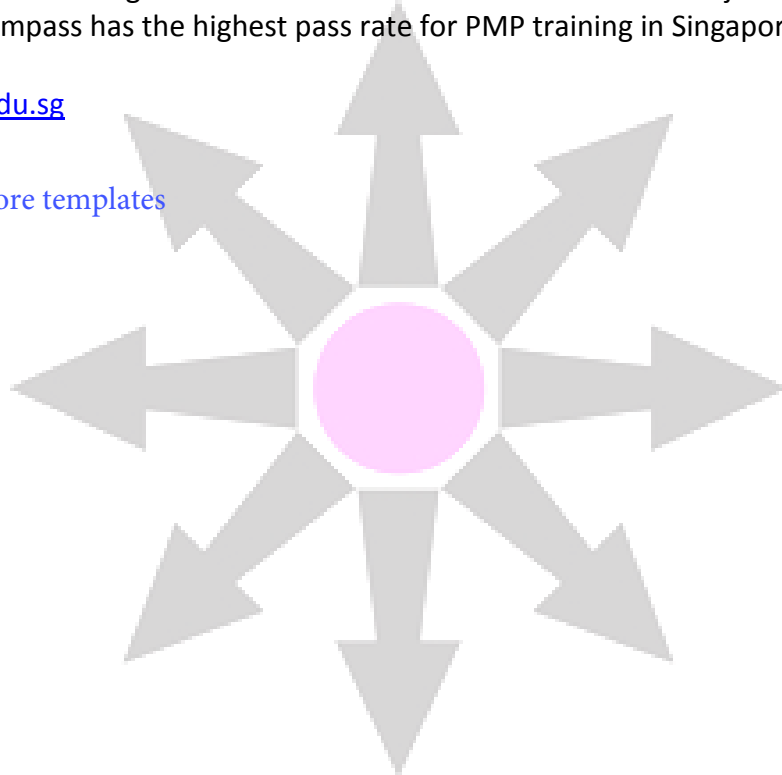
